Attached you will find the programs for both days. (Times are approximate and may be subject to change.)



Senior Room:




This week the senior room has been working hard to complete their marine animal studies and have started their posters, some students having already completed theirs, ready for presentation.

VacSwim offers fun swimming lessons over the October and summer school holidays. It aims to give children across Western Australia the skills to stay safe and confident in the water.

Who can enrol - Children aged 5 to 17 years old across swimming stages 1 to 16.

One program per child - To ensure a fair and equitable opportunity for all children to enjoy VacSwim, enrolment is limited to one program per child. This means:

- One enrolment permitted for October programs.
- One enrolment permitted for summer programs (December and January).

Families can register on a waitlist for additional programs if desired.

When enrolments open and close - Enrolments open Tuesday 5 August 2025.

October enrolments close Tuesday 26 August 2025.

Summer enrolments close Wednesday 15 October 2025.

Do you live more than 4.5km from your child's school and outside of a designated Public Transport Area?


You may be eligible for Transport Assistance.
